Guidance Staff & Responsibilities

We have a team of 4 School Counselors. Students are assigned to a counselor by the first letter of their last name:

- Katie Shelton E L; Department Chair
- Lisa Dufault A D; Plus students who are a part of the Aquinas Program. She is the Director of that program which includes all students who have IEPs, Academic Support Plans, English Language Learners.
- Carli Urcheck M R
- Brennan Schlabig S Z

As school counselors, there are 3 broad domains in which we support students and these are: Academic, Career, Social/Emotional Development. In our day to day, we strive to collaborate/consult with teachers, administration, school staff, and families in order to support the success and goals of our students. In working with our students, if we find that the student's needs extend beyond what we can provide, we will make a referral to outside services in the community.

Lisa, Carli, Brennan and I work closely with a number of people:

- Dr. Sharon Murphy (Clinical Psychologist)- Dr. Murphy can help link our students with resources; Facilitates our Student Wellness Team and takes the lead on Wellness Programming for our faculty, students, and parents.

- Lisa Monroe / Denise Etgen (Intervention)
- Danielle Polemeni / Katherine Stark (ELL Support)
- Dave Himmelrick (School Psychologist)
- Pivot Point Clinical Counselors Lynsey Pearson, Sarah Sparhawk
- NEW this year: Dr. Kathy Wallace will be serving as a College Liasion and Writing Coach; Danielle Polemeni will also have some time built in her day to provide close support in the area of college counseling primarily for students who will be first generation.

Student Wellness Team

All of the counselors and Dr. Murphy are a part of a Student Wellness Team along with our school nurse and 4-5 other faculty members. We meet weekly to discuss students of concern and generate a plan of action for that student. We have established a way for faculty and staff to refer students of concern to the wellness team.

Schedule Change Process

There was a brief write up in the DeTales that went out today regarding schedule changes. Beginning Friday, August 25th, students may request a change to their schedule by visiting their School Counselor to pick up a schedule change request form and subsequently collect teacher and parent signatures. Once form is returned with fee, the change can be made officially in PowerSchool. Prior to August 25th, students may only request a schedule change if they believe an error was made (i.e. incorrect course level, a period with no class, two classes scheduled for the same period, a class that shows up twice, etc). No other schedule change requests will be considered prior to August 25th. Schedule change requests must be resolved by Wednesday, August 30th. Schedules are expected to go live in PowerSchool by Friday of this week. Freshmen will receive at orientation tomorrow.

Autumn Awards Assembly: Friday, September 1st at 9:45am Recognize students who achieved honor roll all 4 quarters during the 2022-2023 school year as well as scholarship recipients for the current school year. There is a Generosity Meets Gratitude breakfast prior to the assembly which allows the student scholarship recipients to connect with the scholarship benefactors.
