Prom and After Prom Rules

- 1. No alcohol or drugs will be allowed. All school rules apply, including no visible tattoos, no nose rings, and no earrings or facial hair for male students.
- 2. Doors @ Villa Milano will open at 6:00 pm. Dinner will be served promptly at 7:00 pm. Please be on time. If you have not arrived by 7:00 pm a parent will be called. No student may leave prior to 10:30 pm. Hours of the after prom are 11:30 p.m. to 1:30 a.m.
- 3. Spring Student Athletes are required to attend After Prom.
- 4. Students attending After Prom must remain until the conclusion of the event. Students will not be released prior to 12:45am.
- 5. Any junior or senior at St. Francis DeSales may attend. No guests from other schools will be permitted this year. This policy will be revisited in April to evaluate the current guidelines.
- 6. Dances are important social events for students and provide a structured forum for socializing and expression. However, the school must maintain a reasonable standard of appropriate behavior and dance movement. Inappropriate dancing WILL NOT be permitted. Any student dancing in a manner that is offensive to any chaperone will be removed from the dance floor. If dancing is found to be offensive the student may be sent home and his or her parents will be notified. The following guidelines will be used to determine appropriate behavior and dance styles.

The following dance styles are NOT permitted:

- a. Lewd or suggestive dancing (grinding. dirty dancing, etc)
- b. Movements that advocated violence (moshing, slamming, etc.)
- c. Movements that threaten student safety.
- 7. For After Prom, students should dress in casual clothes and wear comfortable shoes. Shorts and t-shirts are suggested. Students will have access to the swimming pool, climbing walls, courts, and lounge areas. Students should pack bathing suits and a change of clothes if they plan to utilize the pool. Bathing suits are expected to be *modest* in keeping with our guidelines. Students cannot swim in street clothes. Changing areas with hangers and racks will be available. Keep valuables with a parent chaperone.
- 8. Students will have access to the locker rooms both at the pool area and gym areas for use during the event.
- 9. After school functions are considered an extension of the school day and appropriate behaviors are required. The Student Code of Conduct defines appropriate behavior. This includes being respectful to all faculty, staff, and volunteers.
- 10. Prizes will be awarded throughout the night at After Prom courtesy of the Mother's Club. Winners must be present at the end of the evening to receive their prize.
- 11. Volunteer parents and faculty/staff chaperones will be patrolling the parking lot.
